A very small Ricky Carmicheal, Greg Rand, Robbie Skaggs, Robbie Reynard, Tony Hayes and Kevin Windham ripped it every weekend. To this day I still love seeing and hearing a talented kid race a 80cc bike. In 1991 these kids were magic.

Windham stood out of the group. I remember him and his dad hitting the races at Dade City and Gainsville in a white van and tearing up the tracks on his team green Kawasaki.
